Village of Fort Sumner opens new Municipal MVD office

SANTA FE — The Village of Fort Sumner has partnered with the Motor Vehicle Division (MVD) to open a new municipal office at 277 E. Ave C, Fort Sumner, NM 88119.

The Fort Sumner MVD officially opened on Monday, Jan.6, and is open Monday through Friday from, 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. and from 1 to 4:30 p.m.

Currently, the Fort Sumner provides vehicle-related services only, such as registrations and titles. Services for driver transactions, such as driver's licenses, are not yet available.

Before the office opened, residents in the area had to travel 37 miles away to Melrose or 44 miles to Santa Rosa. For MVD services.
